Family Service League-FREE Crisis Response Services
for those working in long-term care facilities!

Family Service League's Community Crisis Action Team (C-CAT) has helped staff from schools, businesses, and agencies cope after traumatizing events. The Coronavirus has exposed long-term healthcare workers, as well as support and management staff to multiple traumas. Our team of mental health professionals, trained by the International Critical Incident Stress Foundation (ICISF), have seen that debriefing and counseling helps individuals and groups recognize the effects of trauma and identify coping strategies. This model builds on strengthening bonds through group and peer support.

#### What participants can expect:

A voluntary, confidential opportunity for those working in long-term care facilities to share stress reactions and learn new coping skills via telehealth audio/video conferencing.

Education, support, and linkages to additional services.

Mitigation of post-traumatic stress reactions.

An efficient way to identify individuals who may need assistance that is more intensive such as one-on-one counseling.

An opportunity for staff to recognize stress in others, provide mutual support, and build cohesion.

Individuals working in any long-term healthcare environment are welcome to join a C-CAT support session. This is also a unique opportunity for employers and department managers to offer their staff the vital resource of direct counseling during this time of crisis.

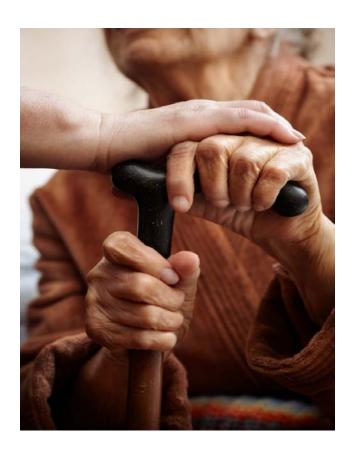

### Family Service League's **Caregiver Support & Education Program**

Family Service League offers a support and education program that can help people caring for a frail or elderly relative to cope with the inherent stress of their situation.

The program, open to residents throughout Suffolk County, provides group and individual counseling. Lending support to help caregivers better handle the complex emotions they experience such as fear, guilt, anger, and anxiety. Caregivers learn new coping skills for stress, gain a better understand of their role and help securing any resources that may be available.

Additionally, educational sessions are provided to community groups and businesses in a "lunch and learn" format. Topics covered are dementia, elder law, nutrition, reducing caregiver stress and long term care planning.

#### **CRISIS CARE FOR CHILDREN, ADULTS, AND FAMILIES**

FSL's Diagnostic, Assessment, and Stabilization Hub (DASH) offers 24 hour, 7 day a week, year round crisis care at a community based site. The program is available to Suffolk residents who struggle with mental health and substance use disorders. Assessments, counseling, and care management intervention is available for children 5 years or older, adolescents, and adults.

The goal of crisis intervention is to provide quality care while reducing unnecessary use of emergency departments, inpatient care, and criminal justice services.

- DASH Team includes nurse practitioners in psychiatry, registered nurses, social workers, credentialed alcoholism and substance abuse counselors, and peer specialists
- Mobile Crisis Team (MCT) delivers crisis care to schools, businesses, homes, and other locations throughout the community
- Length of stay can be up to 24 hours
- Supportive and comfortable environment
