SUBMISSION OF ADDITIONAL COPIES OF HARDSHIP DECLARATIONS TO THE COURT SYSTEM BY EMAIL OUTSIDE NEW YORK CITY

Important: These instructions are for tenants sending Hardship Declarations <u>outside the City of New York</u>. Tenants inside the City of New York should follow instructions on the NYC Civil Court "Important Eviction Legislation" webpage. (<u>www.courts.state.ny.us/courts/nyc/civil/CORONA/covid-</u> <u>eefpa.shtml</u>).

Important Notice to Tenants Outside New York City:

- Under the New York State COVID-19 Emergency Eviction and Foreclosure Prevention Act (EEFPA), tenants <u>who are not parties in a</u> <u>pending action</u> should send their Hardship Declaration to their landlord or their landlord's agent.
- 2. Tenants <u>who are parties in a pending case</u> can also send the Hardship Declaration to their landlord or their landlord's agent. In the alternative, they may send (file) their Hardship Declaration to the Court – filing it by mail, by electronic filing through NYSCEF (if the case is an e-filed matter), or sending it through the Court System's Electronic Document Delivery System (EDDS) to participating courts [https://iappscontent.courts.state.ny.us/NYSCEF/live/edds.htm]. (Please note: in-person delivery of Hardship Declarations to the court in a pending case is allowed, but is strongly discouraged during the COVID pandemic.) Hardship Declarations sent (filed) in this manner will become part of the formal case file.
- <u>Whether or not they are parties in a pending case</u>: tenants outside New York City may send <u>an additional copy</u> of their Hardship Declaration to the Court by attaching it <u>as a pdf</u> to an email sent to the following address:

OutsideNYCResEvictionHardshipDeclaration@nycourts.gov

Hardship Declarations sent to this email address will be stored in a database that can be searched by court system personnel before a case is heard.

Important:

 If the tenant is already a party in a pending eviction case, the Subject line of the email <u>must</u> have the following information: <u>Tenant's Name –</u> <u>Tenant's Full Address – Case Index Number – Court – County</u>.

Example:

Subject: James Smith – 25 Beacon Street, Newtown, New York 12020 – No. 94568-2019 – Newtown Town Court – Saratoga County

 If the tenant is not a party in a pending case, the "Subject" line in the tenant's email to the Court <u>must</u> have the following information: <u>Tenant's Name – Tenant's Full Address – County</u>.

Example:

Subject: Jose Ramos – 121 North Avenue, Oldtown, New York 12201 – Albany County

Important:

- 1. Don't forget to fill out all identifying information in the Subject line!
- 2. Don't forget to attach the Hardship Declaration as a pdf to the email!

3. Remember that this option to send <u>an additional copy</u> of the Hardship Declaration is provided solely for the convenience of the tenant. It is not required by the EEFPA.
